DAY ONE: “Risk Assessment Workshop – It’s More Than a JSA!”

Workshop objectives:

1. Discuss the major components of the ANSI/ASSE Z690 Risk Management Framework and describe how to apply each of the components in their organization.
2. Demonstrate an understanding of at least four common risk assessment tools as well as their advantages and applicable situations.
3. Create a risk matrix with risk factors and definitions that is customized to their organization and utilize the matrix in the risk assessment of two common work tasks in their organization, including risk identification, risk analysis, and risk treatment.
4. Identify their organization’s top five risks and discuss how the application of risk management can demonstrate reduction to an acceptable risk level.



Pam was part of the development team and is one of the instructors for the highly acclaimed ASSE Risk Assessment Certificate program. She is a Professional Member of ASSE as well as a member of the Society Finance Committee; a member of the Council on Professional Affairs Committee; and the Student Section Liaison for the Western Pennsylvania Chapter. DAY TWO – “Combustible Dust - Managing the Process”

Presentation Objectives:

This presentation will present a 3-phase, step by step approach on how to manage the combustible dust hazards in your workplace. This risk management based approach is based on National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards will provide a roadmap. The seminar will discuss the various laboratory tests that need to be considered and how to interpret the data. In addition, once it’s been determined that the dust is combustible then a Dust Hazard Analysis (DHA) needs to be conducted to determine risks involved. Controls to prevent combustible dust explosions will also be covered.



Harold is a member of ASSE and sat on the NFPA 30 Operations Committee from 2001 – 2016. He has a diverse background including 32 years in heavy industry, six years in the heavy construction, and over 30 years in the fire service filling a wide variety of positions in the organizations including Loss Prevention, Fire Protection, Business Continuation planning.

Corporate Combustible Dust Committee and helped develop the Alcoa Combustible Dust Program including development of a safe large scale combustible dust cleaning process utilizing a vacuum truck.
